August 9<sup>th</sup> marked the United Nation's (UN) International Day of the World's Indigenous Peoples.

The UN estimates that there are more than 476 million indigenous people in the world, spread across 90 countries and representing 5,000 different cultures, who constitute 6.2 per cent of the global population and live in all geographic regions.

Like all UN International days and weeks, which are marked to educate the public on issues of concern, and to mobilize political will and resources to address global problems, the International Day of the World's Indigenous Peoples is also celebrated to recognize the contributions and achievements of indigenous communities and to highlight the plight they face in their existence.

Since 1997, PWRDF has been supporting and accompanying indigenous communities and organizations through its **Indigenous Development Program**.

This year, on this special day, PWRDF announced a new initiative in Canada.

This new program, named **The Indigenous Responsive Program**, and its grant application process, were developed in consultation with PWRDF's Indigenous Program Advisory Committee (IPAC).

Indigenous-led communities, organizations and Anglican Dioceses working with Indigenous-led organizations, are invited to apply for a grant from the **Responsive Program**, in amounts between \$5,000 to \$15,000, for programming that supports safe water, youth engagement, community health and/or climate action.

Through this **Responsive Program** grant, PWRDF aims to enlarge its overall Indigenous Development Program and enhance its relationships in order to learn more about the First Nations, Métis, and Inuit communities in Canada.
