

From the Office of the Nominating Committee Positions Available

- a. **The Director of the Board of Christian Education (BCE)** under the leadership of the Senior Pastor and the Board of Deacons, shall plan, coordinate, supervise and evaluate all components of the teaching activities of the church. This shall include Bible Study, Church School, Contemporary Bible Study, and all other groups and classes operating in the field of Christian Education. The Board of Christian Education shall promote study classes as the church may request.
- b. **The Assistant Director of the Board of Christian Education (BCE)** shall assume the duties of the Director in his/her absence. The Assistant Director shall be responsible for special projects and a variety of duties as assigned.
- c. **The offices of General Church School Superintendent and Assistant Superintendents** shall be recommended by the Nominating Committee and elected annually by the Church at the Third Quarterly Church Conference. The General Superintendent shall be the Executive Head of Cross Training (Church School), exercising the authority and performing the duties pertaining to the office.
- d. **The Audit committee** shall consist of seven (7) members and two (2) alternates appointed annually not to exceed three (3) consecutive terms. If any of the auditors miss three (3) consecutive audits, they will be replaced by one of the alternates. The primary purpose of this committee is to examine the financial records of the church and to make written reports of the status of same to the membership at the quarterly meetings. No spouses or immediate family members shall serve on the Audit Committee at the same time
