Dear Church Family,

Happy New Year! As we enter into 2021, I'm pleased to pass along this financial update to you, which reflects the faithfulness of God in the midst of crisis and the deep commitment of so many of you to the work of the gospel in and through our congregation. Thank you!

Please note that these pages contain our cash-basis numbers for the 2020 year, not our final, "official" financial reports. Those will come in a couple of months' time, ahead of our 2021 AGM.

Friends,

The year 2020 was a very unusual year for Southwood, as it was for the rest of the world. In adapting to this unprecedented situation, the Council and staff have undertaken many decisions on your behalf to keep Southwood as vibrant as possible. In that vein, we have cashed out our Legacy Fund for approximately \$16,000 and have received from the SCW some \$18,000 in transfers. Moreover, you as members and adherents have continued your amazing support for this church. As such, I am happy to report that we achieved a small surplus for this year (when assessed using cash-basis accounting). Accordingly, I am happy to report that the bank balance of December 31st was approximately \$3,227, with nothing outstanding on our line of credit. Considering that we began this crisis in February with \$25,000 drawn on our LOC this is nothing short of a miracle.

Moreover, we received two late deposits in December which were not reflected in our bank account until January, and as such we are beginning the new year with approximately \$24,000 in our account. Additionally, we have applied for a provincial grant of approximately \$5,000 to cover unique COVID costs.

To temper this good news, we continue to receive a reduced CEWS (wage) subsidy from the Federal government of approximately \$8,500 per month, which is down from approximately \$12,000 per month earlier in the year. Accordingly, until we can get all of our tenants back, we will probably run deficits for the first three of four months of this year of approximately \$5,000 per month. We will also be reviewing our CEWS grant applications and making enquires as to why this reduction occurred.

As always, I continue to be blessed and humbled by your continuing commitment and support to Southwood and its important ministry.
