What it's like to live in Preeceville:

The town of Preeceville, known as the headwaters of the Assiniboine River, is located in the beautiful East-central Parkland region of Saskatchewan, Canada. The population of the town is 1200 but it serves an area of 5000 people including the R.M. of Preeceville and surrounding communities who work, play and shop in the town of Preeceville.

The main industries are farming, ranching and logging. There are also hog barns, farming implement dealerships, and jobs in the education and health sectors. The beautiful landscape of parkland, farmland, forest and river valleys with provincial parks, historic sights and cultural heritage richness make Preeceville a great place to live.

Fishing, hunting, canoeing, hiking and cross-country skiing are popular recreation activities in the area. We also have many snowmobiling and ATV trails as well as ski and hiking trails. There are many recreational sport opportunities for children and adults including hockey, baseball, dance, cross-country skiing, and 4H.

Preeceville has a beautiful sportsgrounds with ball diamonds and a racing track. There is an annual Western Weekend full of chuckwagon and chariot races, gymkhana and other activities. Preeceville has a K-12 school that also features a pre-school for children aged 3-4. There are many sport and extra-curricular opportunities for students including golf, cross-country running, volleyball, basketball, badminton, track and field, football and band.

Preeceville has a large grocery store, a Co-op and Home Hardware, two fuel stations and a bank. We also have a lawyers' office, dental office, library, pharmacy, gym/fitness center, hotel and several restaurants. There is a hospital with emergency services and a long-term care facility. Preeceville is 100km from the city of Yorkton.
