Lest We Forget

Jeremiah 2:32; 18:14-15

From Sunday September 16th, 2021

Take a moment to pray for the Lord to still your mind, as well as direct your thoughts, conversation and response to the study.

Appetizer:

Question: What is something that you used to be really good at, but that you have now forgotten?

Main Course:

Ask the group this question: What are some things Christian forget about their Christian experiences?

Read: Jeremiah 18:14-15 together

Discussion: What do you notice about this passage? In what ways do the people of God forget Him? What do you think the ancient paths are?

Discussion: What is at stake when a society forgets its lessons learns? What are some things that we have noticed that society has forgotten?

Bible: Paul mentioned in Romans 15:15 that it is important to be reminded of the things of God. Peter, and Timothy, and Titus all did the same thing.

Look up 2 Timothy 2:14 and Titus 3:1-2: What are some things that the people of God need to be reminded of?

Dessert:

In Jeff's sermon on Sunday he suggested that one of the best ways the people of God remember the things of God is through what he called "Predictable Patterns." Predictable patterns are rituals or practices that are routine and that people can count on.

In the Bible, predictable patterns included worship together as well as remembering the character of God through Feasts.

What are some predictable patterns that you have or that you have experienced that help you remain focused on the things of God?

Challenge to the group:

This fall we are commit to:

Making every moment an encounter. What is a predictable pattern that each of us can adopt in order to help us be reminded of the presence of God?

Seeing every Person as a Friend. What is a predictable pattern that each of us can adopt in order to dignify or care for another person?

Providing every Neighbourhood a pastor. What is a predictable pattern that each of us can adopt when it comes to making ourselves available to our neighbours or co-workers>?

Closing in prayer:

Take time to pray that God would give each one of us the boldness to remember him through purposeful activities in all the areas of our lives.
