Activity:

Tell your children to imagine they’ve moved to Germany for the rest of their lives. Then talk about the changes you’d have to make if you moved to Germany.

Ask/Discuss:

- Would you eventually forget what it was like to live in America?

Read:

Daniel 1

Say:
