

(Please bring your pet forward for a blessing. Please be aware that all safety protocols concerning COVID-19 are observed. As your pet is presented for a blessing, please maintain a 2 metre distance from the presider while your pet is receiving this blessing.)

O Blessed Lord of all creation, sustainer of all worlds, in whom all things are brought together in one; unite us in faith, hope and love that in you and by you, all life may be valued as sacred, the earth be healed, and your reign of justice, freedom and peace be made real through us, in all we do, for the love of Him who is the Prince of Peace Jesus Christ the Lord. **Amen.**

Lord's Prayer:

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread.

(This will help us manage our capacity limits at this time.) You will need to wear a mask, be distanced in the church except within family groups or established bubbles, and use hand sanitizer when entering the church. The service will be livestreamed and recorded as well as being in-person. The Bishop encourages those who are unvaccinated to watch the online services.

Thursday morning services are now being held at 10:30 am in the chapel. Everyone is welcome at this mid-week Eucharist service.
