



Is budgeted to come from contribution income, which represents the third straight year of increases to contribution income, a sign of community vibrancy.



## VOLUNTEER HOURS IN WORSHIP


Worship informs and forms us as disciples of Christ. Through reading, greeting, altar guild, and more, we develop and practice the skills which support our other areas of ministry.
