

**Text: Exodus Chapter 19-20** 

- 1. In Exodus 3:12 the Lord said this to Moses. "I will certainly be with you. And this shall be a sign to you that I have sent you: When you have brought the people out of Egypt, you shall serve God on this mountain." Why do you think God gave this as a sign to Moses?
- 2. In Exodus 19, God demanded that the people take serious precautions before He came to them. What, if any, precautions should we take before entering a time of worship today?
- 3. Are we bound to the law's presented in Exodus 20 in the same say that Israel was? Can you support your answer with scripture?
- 4. The people responded to the giving of the law with fear, asking for Moses to be their mediator. What is a mediator? Are we still in need of a mediator today?
- 5. The first commandment is that Israel was to have no other gods before Yahweh. In 20:22-26 He affirms His desire. What are some things that people in our time place above Yahweh? Do you see this happening in our world? Within the church?
