We are checking COVID vaccination status and please remember that masks will be mandatory for everyone over the age of 12. There will be a sign in sheet for everyone to sign.

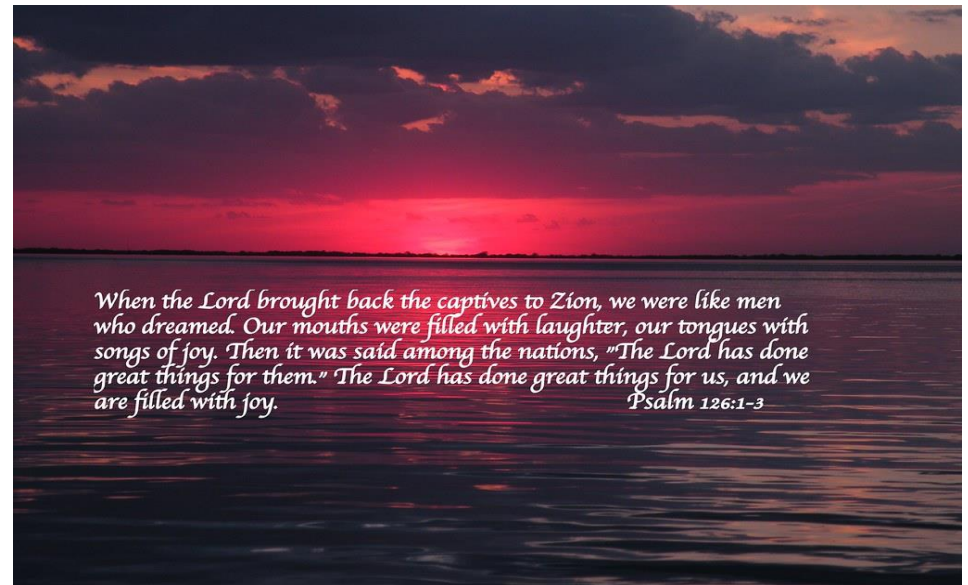
