# Faith Community Certificate Program

Be part of a transformative

faith and justice in Winnipeg's  
Inner City



## The Program

Those who enrol in the 1 Just City Faith Community Certificate program will have the opportunity to learn in community with other adults who are seeking to grow in their faith and understanding of the realities faced by those living in poverty. Participants will have the opportunity to volunteer at all of 1 Just City's sites, meet people from different walks of life, hear engaging speakers. They will be expected to complete a project that will strengthen the connection between 1JustCity and their congregation.

We will be using an adult education model that is participatory, where we learn from each other and from reflecting on our experience as well as from speakers and readings. Sessions will include theological reflection and Bible study.
