India Missions - Mani Pagidipalli

All India Institute of Medical Sciences is the premier medical institute in India and its chief is predicting a 3rd wave of COVID-19. Originally predicted around October; this fresh prediction appears to be much earlier than before.

We are hearing that the 3rd wave will impact all age groups but predominantly those of pediatric age group. Though we are continuing to our work during this current crisis. We are praying fervently that they won't come to pass but we are gearing up to meet the needs of pediatric medical emergencies.

Thankfully by the providence and grace of our God, we found a manufacturer who promised to deliver one in around a month. This is a massive investment both monetarily and infrastructure wise. But this will be a giant achievement in furthering the Lord's work here in India.

We paid the down-payment, and are currently getting the groundwork to setup a transformer, electric requirements, a building to house the oxygen generator. This generator is capable of filling two hundred cylinders per day.
