

1 Authority for Revelation

- We have been given Authority for Revelation (Revealing)
- Authenticates Gospel Message
- Proves God's Victory
 - An our Adoption as Sons and Daughters
- Displays and Enforces Satan's Defeat
- The Revealing of all this is for the Glory of Our Father

2 Read Joshua 10:3-15,22-25

- Joshua is an Old Testament type of Christ – foreshadowing who Jesus is. We can learn from Old Testament types. They shed light on New Testament Truth.
 1. Verse 3 – Adoni-zedek (means Lord of Righteousness) – he was a false lord of a false righteousness
 2. Verse 8 – Don't be afraid. The victory is given to us.
 3. Verse 11 – God does the hard work
 4. Verse 12 – Pray on the Day (Manifest Moment) of Victory
 5. Verse 24 – “Come and put your feet on the false lord of righteousness's neck.” – Our next to Jesus' foot.

3 Mt 18:18 – Binding/Loosing – Earth/Heaven

¹⁸ Truly I tell you, whatever you forbid and declare to be improper and unlawful on earth must be what is already forbidden in heaven, and whatever you permit and declare proper and lawful on earth must be what is already permitted in heaven.

- Perfect Passive Tense – Accomplished in past with results that keep working in the present..
 - We Bind – Because He has already Bound
 - We Loose – Because He has already Loosed
- We are here to bring agreement on Earth with what has already happened in Heaven.
- Authority to Reveal Spiritual Reality

4 Satan's Four Major Defeats

1. Cast out of Heaven
2. Jesus' death, burial and resurrection
3. 1000 year imprisonment during 1000 peace on Earth
4. Final defeat and final punishment
5.
 - In Genesis, at the fall of man, God prophesied (revealed future outcome) the serpent's defeat.
 - Serpent would Bruise Christ's heel
 - Christ would Crush the head (authority) of the serpent
 - This has been fulfilled.

5 Colossians 2:15 AMP

[God] disarmed the principalities and powers that were ranged against us and made a bold display *and* public example of them, in triumphing over them in Him *and* in it [the cross].

6 Matthew 28:18-20 – ALL AUTHORITY

18 Jesus came and told his disciples, “I have been given all authority in heaven and on

earth. ¹⁹Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. ²⁰Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

- THE AGE is rapidly coming to its' end.
- What does this Authority mean to us? What does it look like in our lives?

7 **Luke 4:5-8 Kingdoms and Authority (temptation)**

Then the devil took him up and revealed to him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time. ⁶"I will give you the glory of these kingdoms and authority over them," the devil said, "because they are mine to give to anyone I please. ⁷I will give it all to you if you will worship me."

⁸ Jesus replied, "The Scriptures say, 'You must worship the LORD your God and serve only him.'"

- This was the ultimate temptation for Christ because it was an invitation to take a shortcut to achieve God's purpose.

8 **Luke 9:1,2, 6 Jesus Gives Disciples Authority**

¹ One day Jesus called together his twelve disciples and gave them power and authority to cast out all demons and to heal all diseases. ² Then he sent them out to tell everyone about the Kingdom of God and to heal the sick.

⁶ So they began their circuit of the villages, preaching the Good News and healing the sick.

- This is what we look like when we walk in this Authority.

9 **Luke 10 1-23 Seventy-two prepare the way.**

¹ The Lord now chose seventy-two other disciples and sent them ahead in pairs to all the towns and places he planned to visit. ² These were his instructions to them: "The harvest is great, but the workers are few. So pray to the Lord who is in charge of the harvest; ask him to send more workers into his fields. ³ Now go, and remember that I am sending you out as lambs among wolves. ⁴ Don't take any money with you, nor a traveler's bag, nor an extra pair of sandals. And don't stop to greet anyone on the road.

¹⁶ Then he said to the disciples, "Anyone who accepts your message is also accepting me. And anyone who rejects you is rejecting me. And anyone who rejects me is rejecting God, who sent me."

¹⁷ When the seventy-two disciples returned, they joyfully reported to him, "Lord, even the demons obey us when we use your name!"

¹⁸ "Yes," he told them, like "I saw Satan fall from heaven lightning!" ¹⁹ Look, I have given you authority over all the power of the enemy, and you can walk among snakes and scorpions and crush them. Nothing will injure you. ²⁰ But don't rejoice because evil spirits obey you; rejoice because your names are registered in heaven."

Jesus' Prayer of Thanksgiving

²¹ At that same time Jesus was filled with the joy of the Holy Spirit, and he said, "O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, thank you for hiding these things from those who think themselves wise and clever, and for revealing them to the childlike. Yes, Father, it pleased you to do it this way.

²² "My Father has entrusted everything to me. No one truly knows the Son except the Father, and no one truly knows the Father except the Son and those to whom the Son chooses to reveal him.

- Revelation of Satan's Defeat

- This Authority brings Faith to the Believer.

10 **John 20:14,15,40-44 – Lazarus Revelation**

¹⁴ So he told them plainly, "Lazarus is dead. ¹⁵ And for your sakes, I'm glad I wasn't there, for now you will really believe. Come, let's go see him."

40 Jesus responded, "Didn't I tell you that you would see God's glory if you believe?" ⁴¹ So they rolled the stone aside. Then Jesus looked up to heaven and said, "Father, thank you for hearing me. ⁴² You always hear me, but I said it out loud for the sake of all these people standing here, so that they will believe you sent me." ⁴³ Then Jesus shouted, "Lazarus, come out!" ⁴⁴ And the dead man came out, his hands and feet bound in graveclothes, his face wrapped in a headcloth. Jesus told them, "Unwrap him and let him go!"

- REV – Father Sent Jesus "BELIEVE IT!"
- REV – of God's Glory – When we believe we see God's Glory.

11 **John 14:12-14 – Ask Anything – In My Name**

¹² "I tell you the truth, anyone who believes in me will do the same works I have done, and even greater works, because I am going to be with the Father. ¹³ You can ask for anything in my name, and I will do it, so that the Son can bring glory to the Father. ¹⁴ Yes, ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it!"

- Ask (anything) in my name, and I will do it.
- Ask in my name (anything, and I will do it!
- Final Purpose of Authority is – Glory to the Father.

12 **Romans 8:31 – A Declaration of Authority**

13 **Jude 24,25 Pray**

²⁴ Now all glory to God, who is able to keep you from falling away and will bring you with great joy into his glorious presence without a single fault. ²⁵ All glory to him who alone is God, our Savior through Jesus Christ our Lord. All glory, majesty, power, and authority are his before all time, and in the present, and beyond all time! Amen.
