KEY VERSE

SERIES OVERVIEW

God is so cool that even when we think we will not be good enough, smart enough, strong enough, he reminds us that he is more than enough. In fact, all through God's story, he shows that he is powerful by teaming up with the weak, the underdog, and the unqualified. Moses was a baby that should have been killed at birth, but God had plans to take that underdog from the Nile River, and turn him into the leader of God's people. And when Moses thought that he wasn't a good enough speaker, God said, "I want to use you anyway!" Because God loves a good underdog story.

1 | Ask

INSTRUCTIONS

Ask your child:

- What does it mean to have a weakness? (It's something that you're not good at)
- What's an area in which you're "weak" that you wish you were good at?

2 | Read

INSTRUCTIONS

Read Exodus 4:18-7:13. Ask your child:

- What's one thing that stood out to you in the story?
- What's the connection with the Big Idea?

3 | Watch

INSTRUCTIONS

Watch the video teaching with your family this week. Talk about the video as a family.

- What stood out to you?
- What did you like?
- What did you want to ask a question about?

(Tip: If its helpful, consider pausing the video as you watch it together, and ask questions or talk about things that stick out to you as you go!)
