Mission: Building New Lives on Jesus. Together.

KEY PASSAGE

Using S.O.I.L. method

Ephesians 4:11-16

INTRO: Ice Breaker (for fun!): What's your favorite rainy day activity?

*Open with a short prayer for the discussion and invite the Holy Spirit into the meeting.

SCRIPTURE: Read aloud: Ephesians 4:11-16 (You can ask several people to take turns reading)

Discuss how the text relates to Cornerstone's Mission (outlined below) using these three simple Bible study tools: Lightbulb, Question Mark, Arrow

(Lightbulb) - What's stands out to you about the passage?

INTERPRETATION: (Question Mark) – What questions do you have about the

passage?

LIFE APPLICATION:

(Arrow) – How will you apply this to your life?

<u>Cornerstone's Mission</u>: Building new lives on Jesus. Together.

BUILD: 4:11-12

NEW LIVES: 4:13-14

JESUS: 4:15-16

TOGETHER: 4:16

PJP SAYS: When we focus on the GREAT COLLABORATION to work Together (John 17:22-23) we will keep the GREAT COMMANDMENT to Love (Matthew 22:37), and then, together, we will accomplish the GREAT COMMISSION to reach the Lost (Matthew 28:19-20)!!
