Reflection Questions:

1. "How you see people decides how you treat people." Are you willing to see the vulnerable people in our church's neighbourhood as your brother (or potential brother), instead of a problem to be solved?

- 2. The parable in Matthew 25 builds on the principle in v.26 that failure to utilize our gifts for the Master (sins of omission) as well as overt acts of evil (sins of commission) will be judged. Sins of omission are as serious to God as sins of commission. Will this message affect your view of sins and ministry?
- 3. "As we are loving, serving and helping the vulnerable people and neighbours, we are on mission WITH Jesus, not just FOR Jesus." How does this message give you encouragement and faith to love and serve the neighbours?
