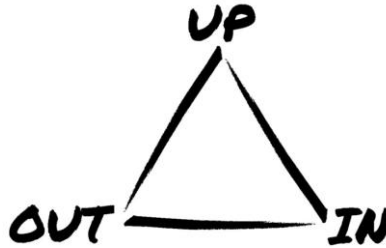


Sermon Questions – October 23-24, 2021



- 1) Review Luke 6:12-19. Pay attention to how Jesus prioritizes the three relational dimensions
 - a. Relationship UP with his Father (v. 12)
 - b. Relationship IN with the family of God (vv. 13-16)
 - c. Relationship OUT with the surrounding world (vv. 17-19)

What stands out to you?

- 2) How do you see these same priorities reflected in the early church (Acts 2:42-47).
- 3) Have each individual in the group do some self-evaluation.

Use the Triangle to consider your own relational priorities. On a scale of 1-10, how would you rate the degree to which you invest in

- a. Your relationship with your Heavenly Father?
- b. Your relationship with other believers?
- c. Your relationships with those who do not yet know Jesus?

Where is Jesus commending you? Where (and how) is he calling for change?

- 4) Have each individual in the group do some “church-evaluation.”

Use the Triangle to consider your relational priorities as a group. On a scale of 1-10, how would you rate the degree to which you (as a group) invest in

- a. Your corporate relationship with our Heavenly Father?
- b. Your relationship with other believers?
- c. Your relationships with those who do not yet know Jesus?

Where is Jesus commending you? Where (and how) might he be calling your group to change? What are 1-2 specific changes you will make and when will you make them?
