

## Exodus 3 – Discussion Questions

To go Along with November 6-7 Sermon by Ian Trigg.

- 1) Ian shared several significant stories of life-change from VAC's past. What are some of your favorite "VAC Moments" (hilarious, encouraging, or stories of God's goodness and grace)?
- 2) The Hebrew people often "looked-back" to the story of Moses and the Exodus when they needed to be reminded of God's care and salvation in difficult times. Remembering his faithfulness to them as a people in the past helped them navigate through difficult times in the present.

Read Psalm 77 as a group. What do you notice?

- When you reflect on days or seasons of darkness in your life, where does your mind go?
  - What was/is happening in those times?
  - What were/are you asking God for in the midst of them?
  - How did he answer your prayer (and how long did it take for the answer to come through)?
  - As you reflect on God's faithfulness in times past, how does this inform how you are living in what may be dark/difficult times now?
- 3) What kind of moments are you longing for in the near future? If appropriate, spend some time right now praying that the Lord would give us some of those "future" stories.
  - 4) Pray for God's presence and faithfulness to be experienced by those in your group walking through difficult valleys.
