Who was Morris?

Have you ever wondered how far a percentage of your estate left to the Cathedral could go – and go indefinitely? Every year, at Vestry, when we look at the Cathedral's financial health and approve a budget for the year,

we hear about the amount drawn from the Morris Fund. And every year, we're grateful for the legacy of Clifford and Caroline Morris.

Cliff Morris was a member of the Cathedral's Property Committee. As fellow Committee member Michael Johnston recalls, this group of men helped Property Manager Chuck Harrison to paint and plaster and do other jobs. Cliff cared deeply about this beautiful historic building and he and Caroline took steps to secure its future. As the Cathedral's Endowment Committee reports annually to Vestry, the Morris bequest of \$200,000 was made in 1989. The funds from the trust were to be used for the structural maintenance of the Cathedral. Only the interest and income of the bequest were to be used for the structural maintenance; the original gift of \$200,000.00 was not to be encroached upon.

The Morris Fund has been managed carefully and now stands at over \$400,000. But here's the happy point: over the years, the amount sent to the Cathedral by this one fund is in the area of \$585,000. As Endowment Committee member Sandy Darling points out, that \$200,000 has produced \$585,000 plus the \$200,000 difference between the original and current value: an amazing total of \$785,000!

This is an inspiring example of one couple and the tremendous difference we can make when we consider the future ministries of the Cathedral in our wills. The phrase "more than we can ask or imagine" comes to mind.
