Jesus our Hope

1. A simple call to follow.

Mark 8:34 (NLT) - Then, calling the crowd to join his disciples, he said, "If any of you wants to be my follower, you must give up your own way, take up your cross, and follow me."

2. A simple call becomes complicated.

Matthew 24:26 (NLT) - "So if someone tells you, 'Look, the Messiah is out in the desert,' don't bother to go and look. Or, 'Look, he is hiding here,' don't believe it!"

3. A return to a simple call to follow.

Acts 4:13 (NLT) - The members of the council were amazed when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, for they could see that they were ordinary men with no special training in the Scriptures. They also recognized them as men who had been with Jesus.
