**Worship Service Procedures at Grace United Church Beginning
November 14, 2021.**

- Each person who wishes to attend the in-person worship service in the sanctuary **must be fully vaccinated.**
- You will be required to show proof of vaccination. Once you have shown proof of vaccination, you will not be required to show it again.
- You are encouraged to pre-register by Thursday evening at 6 p.m.
- **Registration** is by email at gucsignup@gmail.com or by calling 705-441-8326.
- A master list of attendees will be developed for contact tracing and will be kept on file in the church office for 30 days.

On Sunday morning:

- Please do not come to the church service if you have a fever, chills, sore throat, runny nose, breathing issues, unusual headache or feeling unwell.
- If you have come in contact with a positive case of COVID-19 or travelled outside of Canada in the past 14 days please do not attend until the quarantine period has elapsed.

Upon arrival for the service, please:

- Wear a mask at all times
- Enter by the **front door** and check in with the greeter
- Sanitize your hands upon entry
- Proceed to the sanctuary and an usher will direct you to a pew. You will be seated from front to back. Exit will be directed by an usher and will be from back to front.
- If necessary, coats may be hung on the coat rack.
- Cushions may be used in the pews.
- Singing is permitted by members of the congregation and small choir ensembles (masks are worn).
- Monetary contributions may be made by e-transfer, mailing a cheque or by placing a contribution in the offering plate which will be placed at the back of the sanctuary.

If you test positive for COVID-19 within 14 days of attending a service please notify the church by telephone or email address (gucsignup@gamil.com).

These guidelines have been developed and approved by the Safety Commission after consultation with the Grey Bruce Health Unit.
