

## Growth Group Questions – 14/11/2021 – Jack Kapinga

*Read John 6:25-40.*

- 1) According to verse 26, what were the crowds looking for? What does this tell us about many people's ideas about their deepest needs, both back then and today?
- 2) What does Jesus mean in verse 27 when he says we should seek "food that endures to eternal life"? How do we access this kind of food? What's the significance of the food/bread/hungry imagery?
- 3) In the first half of verse 37 Jesus says, "All those the Father gives me will come to me". What does this reveal to us about the Father and about our salvation?
- 4) Do you ever wonder if Jesus has rejected you, let go of you, withdrawn his favour from you? What are some reasons why you sometimes question this?
- 5) In the second half of verse 37 Jesus says, "whoever comes to me I will never drive away." Dwell on these words and share what they really mean to you?
- 6) What does this verse, and similar thoughts throughout this passage, tell us about the heart of our Lord Jesus Christ? Why is it important that we don't just believe in the 'perseverance of the saints' but also in the 'perseverance of the heart of Christ'?
- 7) How does it make you feel to know that if you come to Jesus in faith, then he will never ever drive you away?
