**“God Send Revival”**

*Luke 5:1-11*

“Will You not revive us again that your people may rejoice in You?” (Psalm 85:6). What are we praying for when we ask God to send a revival to our church, community, nation, and world? A revival is not just stirring up interest in the local church or religion in general. Revivals cannot be organized or controlled by any people. God alone sends revival. Almighty God brings profound repentance and gives great cleansing of conscience.

**I. Complacency – *Luke 5:1-5***

- A. The belief that the Lord will not do good, nor will He do evil –  
*Zephaniah 1:12*
  - 1. When there is little to no joy in the ministry of God’s Word is an evidence of complacency.
  - 2. When there is little concern about one’s soul before God, there is spiritual complacency.
  - 3. When God’s Word is only in the mind and not applied inwardly is the result of complacency.
  - 4. When social life; entertainment; acquiring money or possessions; recreation; and sports are in the center of one’s thoughts is an evidence of complacency.
  - 5. When sin is rationalized, there is spiritual complacency.
  - 6. When Christ’s name is taken in vain, there is complacency.
  - 7. When the slightest excuse can keep one from doing their spiritual duty, there is complacency.
  
- B. The Fredericksburg community never experienced what God sent to the rest of the colonies in 1741 – REVIVAL
  - 1. George Whitefield was greatly used in the American colonies to bring revival
  - 2. But he was not permitted to preach in Fredericksburg
  - 3. He shook the dust off his feet and left Fredericksburg – *Matthew 10:14-15*

Was the Battle of Fredericksburg in December 11-15, 1862 the consequence of Fredericksburg resisting revival?  
Was not the battle an American Armageddon? *Ezekiel 3:9, 11-16*

**II. The Word Alone Brings Revival – *Luke 5:5-7***

- A. “At Your Word, I will let down the net”
  - 1. The same God who spoke light into existence, alone saves sinners –  
*2 Corinthians 4:5-6*
  - 2. The complacent must be broken by bold preaching – *Acts 2:22-24, 36-37*
  - 3. The result is grief before God of offending Him – *Zechariah 12:10*
  - 4. In revival, God cleanses the conscience – *Zechariah 13:1*
  - 5. Christ is the water of life – *Revelation 21:6*
  
- B. Revival blesses an entire community or region – *Luke 5:6-7*
  - 1. Many churches will be blessed
  - 2. Revival impacts the peace and prosperity of a community

III. **Humility** – *Luke 5:8-11*

A. “Depart from me for I am a sinful man” – *Luke 5:8*

1. Isaiah saw the holiness of the Lord on His throne and repented – *Isaiah 6:1-7*
2. Revival prophesied – *Zechariah 12:10-11; 13:1*
3. God dwells with the humbled – *Isaiah 57:15*

In revival, the redeemed see the holiness of God and His Lordship over all the earth and are humbled.

B. The Lord commissions those He reveals Himself to – *Luke 5:9-11*

1. Isaiah also sent to serve – *Isaiah 6:8-10*
2. Such going is costly – *Matthew 19:27-29*

**Revival is sent by God to see His glory, His Lordship,  
and to respond to evangelize.**
