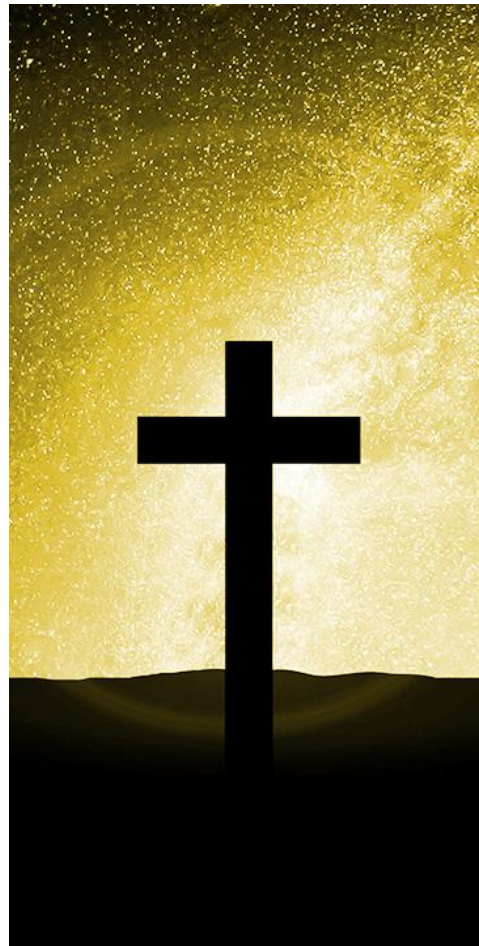

**COVID restrictions. We are currently in STAGE 2:**

The Archdiocese has re-opened churches and ceremonies to “mixed” congregations; the 2 sqm rule applies, and masks must be worn indoors. Vaccinated parishioners are permitted to sing but masks must be worn (a fully vaccinated socially distanced choir of 10 is allowed).

**STAGE 3 90% are fully vaccinated, estimated date 1<sup>st</sup> Dec.** There will be no difference between the Covid safety requirements for all NSW citizens, including weddings and funerals. Masks will not be required inside the church.
