





# OUR AMAZING VOLUNTEERS

Budgets give a big picture of our vision and tell the story of our ministry in a dollar-and-cents way. This year's story will reflect how many of our sources of revenue, such as rental income, have been impacted by the pandemic. However, one contribution to our Cathedral's operations that remains unwavering is the commitment of our volunteers. In a normal year, we estimate that volunteers spend more than 275 hours every week assisting at services, answering phones, arranging flowers, supervising choristers, polishing brass, tending aardens, and hosting special events, to name a few contributions. Our volunteers remain faithful, are very creative and remarkably adaptable, and we look forward to their invaluable work continuing as the Cathedral's re-opening unfolds. Thank you!


### IN 2020 317 ENVELOPE HOLDERS MADE OFFERINGS TOTALLING \$400,112

# PROMISE 2022 WORKSHEET

# PROPORTIONAL GIVING

Rather than suggest the traditional tithe, or giving 10% of your income, we encourage "proportional giving" – where you determine for yourself what percentage of your income is appropriate for you to give to the Cathedral. For example, if your income is \$800 per week and you are giving \$40, or 5% of your income, an increase of 1% (to 6%) will increase your gift to \$48 per week.
