### Christmas White Offering This Year: Chagas Prevention Project

December 19th, 24th and 26th

Through the Chagas project, families receive the treatment and protection they need to overcome the disease. Plastering adobe walls and pouring concrete floors in rural homes significantly decreases a family's risk of infection as their homes are made "vinchuca-proof." Chagas is a disease of the poor and continues to devastate families who live in adobe mud homes. Through the Chagas prevention project, CBM builds strong relationships with communities. This has created opportunities to further partner with families to develop agricultural initiatives that help support families both economically and with nutrition.
