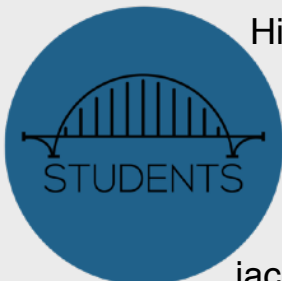

By Faith – Consider Him

1. What is Faith?
2. How should this Faith change my Race?

Faith Defined:

Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. Hebrews 11:1 (NASB)

1. What do I hope for most?
2. Just how convinced are you about the things you cannot see?

Faith in the midst of the race:

*Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us. Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith, who for the joy set before him, endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
-Hebrews 12:1-2 (NIV)*

1. Command #1 – we are to actively repent.

“...let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles.”

2. Command #2 – we are to run with perseverance.

“...and let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us.”

“I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith.” 2 Timothy 4:7

“You were running a good race. Who cut in on you to keep you from obeying the truth?” Galatians 5:7

3. Command #3 – we are to fix our eyes on Jesus.

“...let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith.”

Faith to Consider:

Consider him who endured such opposition from sinful men, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart. Hebrews 12:3 (NIV)

Working definition of “Consider”: Deep contemplation that leads to a decision to act.

Homework Challenge:

1. Is your story about Him?
2. Is your story marked by this kind of faith?
3. Are you willing to consider the commands of Hebrews 12:1-3?
4. If He speaks to you, are you willing to faithfully obey?
