## Locate Your Local Pantry

Food pantries reduce food waste by distributing free food to community members in need. Most food pantries have a service area like a school district. To find the pantry that serves you, it's hours, and address, call 211 (or call 877-947-2211 if you have a non-715 phone number).

## **Bring ID and Address**

You will be asked to complete a simple registration form when you check in at your pantry. You do not need to show proof of income. Bring one proof of identification and one proof of address though.
