We concluded our men's Bible study this past week. Each Tuesday morning for the last twelve weeks we had an awesome group of men gather at 6:30am for Bible study and coffee. This is the first time we've done something like this with our men—at least in my seven years as your pastor. I was excited to give it a try.

I only had a few goals for the class. First, I hoped that we would get to know each other a little better. I desired to create a space for our men to have spiritual fellowship outside the bounds of our normal weekly programming. Many of the men who joined the study are in different Sunday School classes or are serving in different areas of the church on Sundays and Wednesdays. As a result, we all know each other, but we don't get to spend much time together.

Second, I wanted us to grow together in our walk with Jesus as we studied His Word. And we did. Each week the Bible studies were engaging and insightful. I regularly found myself saying "Yes" and "Amen" during our time together. It was such a joy to watch as God worked on His men in our church.

Third, I wanted the Bible study to be simple and sustainable—which is to say, I wanted it to be easy. I already write three sermons per week and often find myself teaching Sunday School. I didn't relish the possibility of an extra assignment of having to come up with another sermon/lesson for however many weeks. We used a video-based format with an easy-to-use Bible study workbook. This did not require any one person to have to take on a huge responsibility. It was very nice.

I am proud to say we accomplished all our goals. To God be the glory. My hope was that ten men would take part. We had sixteen! I want to thank the following men for their part in our class:
