Missionary Corner

Lithuania? Do you know where it is? It is a little country in Eastern Europe. When the Soviet Union broke up 30 years ago the M.B. Missions started a work there which is continuing to this day. At the time (1992) there was one little house church. Today there are eight churches, all part of the M.B. Conference. E. & E. Reimer were sent there by the Mission Board to help in the process. In fact, 6 other folks from this church have served in Lithuania as well.



The NPMB Church has for many years supported one aspect of this ministry financially and that is known as the Good News Clubs. As of January 2022, these Clubs have 20 students from the community. This Good News Club is under the leadership of Solveiga. They meet every afternoon in the local church. All the kids are in the age bracket of 12 to 16 and all are from seriously problematic homes. Over the years quite a few have come to the Lord, were baptized and are now active as believers.

The pastor, Valdas Vaitkevicius, and the leader, Solveiga, need our prayer support. The summer camps these young people attended this summer, and we paid for, were most successful.

The Covid crisis in that country is about the same as here.
