Council Highlights for January 4, 2022

Alyse K opened our council meeting with devotions based on Hosea 14:9 and how we need to ask for God's discernment to help us determine what is wise. There are times when something might be technically right, but this is not always the wise decision. We then drew names from the prayer bowl and spent some time praying over members of our congregation.

We reviewed the requirements for voting at the congregational meeting. Our bylaws require 20% attendance at a congregational meeting to meet quorum and require a 2/3 majority vote to pass for any financial matters. With a congregation of 220 members we needed 44 in attendance; we had 35 in person and 33 online for a total of 68. The vote on the budget was approved by 89.8% of those who voted.

The purpose of our Sunday morning livestream was reviewed. Council would like to thank all of those who have made the livestream what it is today, and those who keep it going every week: it has been a blessing for those in our congregation who are unable to attend in person.

We discussed the next steps to follow with respect to the Human Sexuality Report that is going before Synod, and we are prayerfully reflecting on the best way to work through this with the congregation. We encourage our members to read the report, and we will have paper copies of both the summary and the complete report available at the Welcome Center.

We wrapped up and summarized the work that came out of our strategic planning session in December, and we are excited to share with you our plans for this new year, so look forward to a letter/announcement with more details sometime this month.

We received and processed the transfer in of **Christopher and Lindsay H**, along with their three boys **Ethan**, **Liam**, **and Kade** from Nobleford CRC and we welcome them to our church family! We also received and processed the withdrawal of Dan and Natasha D from our congregation and we wish them blessing in their future church home.
