Church Planters to Papua New Guinea

After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb... —Revelation 7:9

I had the privilege of baptizing twenty people on one Sunday morning in September! It was quite the display of diversity as I looked across the group. Three were from South Africa; one was from Zambia; three were from the New Guinea Islands; and the remainder came from six different tribes on the mainland. If you remember Jackson from the last prayer letter, he also got baptized in that group! Oh how that diversity thrills my heart, as I look forward to the fulfillment of Revelation 7:9. By the end of September, I began receiving phone calls from people throughout the church that they were ill and getting tested for Covid.
