Greetings & Happy New Year From the PoP Congolese Refugee Team:

The needs for a family of eight are at times challenging. Right now they fall into two categories:

Household Items: tissues, toilet paper, paper towels, Selson blue shampoo, bar soap, liquid hand soap, dish detergent, clothes detergent, Clorox wipes, Good Nights Pull Ups — sizes small, medium and large. There is a basket in the church gathering space to collect these items. (*Note these are not covered by the Bridge Card (food stamps*).

Asende, a single mom, is now 100% responsible for all the expenses of running a home, i.e., rent, utilities, phones, etc. It is extremely critical for the welfare of the family that she is working. Therefore, volunteers are **URGENTLY** needed for transport. Asende is working at Summit Polymers, 5858 East N Avenue. She needs a ride to and from work. Pick up is at 5:30 a.m. at 1830 Van Zee Street, Kalamazoo to be at work no later than 6:00 a.m. She is picked up at 2:30 p.m. to go home.


