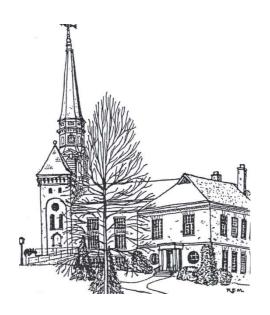

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KILLAM'S POINT DAY CAMP 2021

Killam's Point Day Camp had a very successful summer and we wanted to share some of the details with the church board. Each week was filled to capacity with a waiting list.

Each session had 60-65 campers. The campers were placed according to grade level in seven groups of no more than twelve. Every group had one or two counselors over the age of sixteen and two to three junior counselors aged 13 or older. Daily, the children rotated through swimming and kayaking under the supervision of two waterfront and kayak certified lifeguards. There were nature activities such as hiking, raft building and cave crawling, supervised by a paid staff member. Group games included kickball, SPUD, and parachute games. Craft projects included tie dye, God's eyes, and bird houses. There was also time for snacks, small group activities and relaxation and free play.

This year we were able to add an activity based on social emotional learning skills due to a grant from the Connecticut Department of Education. Thus, we were able to hire a counselor who developed activities to help kids deal with stress, work on team building and practice kindness. Additionally, this grant paid for one special event each week. We had a school social worker give a lesson on mindfulness, a yoga instructor to reach yoga, a meditation teacher to do a meditation exercise and a drama coach to do theater games. The grant also provided full scholarships to seven children.

Further, we became part of a program entitled "College Corps". Through federal funding, college students were offered and opportunity to work at area camps. Having four college students allowed us to keep our camper to staff ration low.

We were able to participate in the Branford Public Schools free lunch program. Every day a staff member picked up lunch from the high school and brought it to camp. Campers could bring their own lunch if they preferred.

Camp fees were \$150 which made the program extremely affordable. Aside from the seven campers awarded scholarships, we had ten additional campers receive some type of financial aid.

We incurred some extra expenses this year as we needed to replenish some supplies from previous years in addition to expenses for COVID precautions.

On the first day of camp, the mother of a long-time camper sent an email saying "We wanted to say "Thank You" for bringing this beautiful piece of summer back! Our son was so joyful, excited, and care-free this morning. We saw him shedding this armor of anxiety and fear that he has been carrying the last year as he entered camp. Thank you isn't really enough to express how much our whole family appreciates you and Killam's Point.

The weeks went smoothly and were able to allow over 300 kids between the ages of 5 and 15 to have a wonderful summer. Another indicator of success are the emails being received asking when camp signups are for next year!

Dawn Perrotti, Camp Director has expressed her thanks for the support of the church for the camp. Betsy and I cannot express how amazing Dawn has been in undertaking the planning, securing grants, staff, lifeguards, kayak instructors and other assets.

The Killam's Point Day Camp this year was successful beyond our highest expectations and FCCB should take pride in the gift they gave to 300 Branford Children. We thank you for your support and look forward to continuing to offer camp next year.
