

## Sermon Notes

## "First Things First" Matthew 6:31-34 Lead Pastor | Bobby Alger February 06, 2022

- **1.** <u>Perceptions</u> we have toward <u>giving</u>. ...remembering the words the Lord Jesus himself said: 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.' (Acts 20:35)
  - <u>Compulsory</u> –something is being <u>taken</u> from me. (II Corinthians 9:7)
  - Responsibility –giving is my obligation. (Malachi 3:9-10)
  - Faith expecting something in return. (II Corinthians 9:10)
- **2. Giving has different benefits** to our lives. So two good things will result from this ministry of giving—the needs of the believers in Jerusalem will be met, and they will joyfully express their thanks to God. (II Corinthians 9:12) NLT
  - First Fruits are gifts of honor connected to increase! (Proverbs 3:9-10)
  - <u>Tithes</u> are gifts of <u>obedience</u> connected to <u>positioning</u> and <u>protection</u>. (Malachi 3:10-12)
  - Offerings are gifts of generosity connected to abundant blessings. (II Corinthians 9:11)
- **3. First Fruits <u>cause</u> God to <u>own</u> your harvest.** The first of all the first fruits of every kind and every contribution of every kind....you shall also give to the priest the first of your dough to cause a blessing to rest on your house. (Ezekiel 44:30) (Romans 11:16)
  - God's blessing stays on your lineage. (Ezekiel 44:30c)
  - God stands <u>guard</u> to fend off <u>predators</u>. (Jeremiah 2:2-3)
- **4.** Practicing First Fruits is another <u>opportunity</u> to exercise <u>faith</u> and receive greater <u>blessing</u>. (Il Corinthians 8:12)
