

Life Group Questions (John 6:22-40)

- 1. Read John 6:22-40 together. What stands out to you from this passage? What questions come to mind? What stood out to you from Sunday's sermon?
- 2. How would you describe the crowd in this passage? Look at there interactions with Jesus in verses 25, 28, 30-31, and 34. Did there understanding of Jesus improve from verses 14-15 or get worse?
- 3. Have you ever struggled with assurance of salvation? How can verses 37-39 help in that?
- 4. Jesus said that whoever came to him would not hunger or thirst or be cast out. Have you experienced Jesus satisfying your spiritual hunger and thirst? How would you describe that?
- 5. Jesus came to satisfy our spiritual hunger and thirst. What kinds of things distract you from him? What kind of things do you seek satisfaction in?
- 6. What are ways you can daily go to Jesus for spiritual nourishment? Why do you think so many Christians find it hard to spend time with Jesus every day?
