## II. Taking Every Thought Captive... 2 Cor.10:5

## A. Understanding Our Thoughts

- a. Thoughts are linking
  - "One thought leads to another"
  - Beliefs "sets" the idea solidifies; reinforces the idea.
  - Repetition implants it—builds a wall, then a stronghold.

ILL.> A cow path

## B. Grip/Grasp: "Taking hald of..."

- "Bringing into captivity"
- Take hold of the thought— We can control what we think!
- Focus on it think about what it is saying.
- Discern Test it; place it next to God's Truth (Word)

### C. Make it obedient to Christ:

A Lie: "Renounce it"

- Confess- I have believed a lie.
- Repent Turn from it; "pull it down."
- Out Loud— Words chase away random thoughts...
  - "I renounce this lie" (belief; idea; thought...)
- This informs the enemy that his lie is exposed.
- Replace it with the truth.

*The Truth: "*Affirm it"
- "I do believe."


