

Live Streaming Grant & Set Up

Thank you to both Armin Hackelsperger and Tony Richard for your weekly ministry of operating the live streaming equipment, enabling folks to participate virtually.

Our parish received a \$2500 grant from the Diocese in 2021 to purchase parish-owned equipment rather than continuing with Armin's and Tony's personally owned equipment. Most of the new equipment has arrived.

In order to accommodate the new equipment, Armin and Tony sent a request to St. Luke's Vestry, seeking permission to remove half of the front pew on the right side of the church, facing the altar, in order to make room for a desk on which to set up the equipment and would no longer be obstructing the center aisle. The vestry passed a motion to grant this request.
