Special Youth and Parent Meeting After Ash Wednesday Service: All Middle & High School youth and parents are invited to a special gathering in Fellowship Hall after the Ash Wednesday service to talk about a potential mission trip to South Dakota, camping and Boundary Water trips this summer, as well as the long-delayed Boston trip for confirmands. Pastor Chris and Alex will both lead this 30-minute gathering. Join us!
