1 | Conversation Starter

SUPPLIES

- a. To lead into today's story, ask:
 - What was the nicest thing that someone did for you this week?
 - Did you do anything nice for someone? If so, what did you do?

2 | Watch

- a. Introduce today's Big Idea: Jesus brings justice.

3 | Discuss

- a. Review the video teaching together:
 - Did anything stand out to you in today's Life Story?
 - What stood out to you in the God Story?
 - How do these stories connect with each other and with the Big Idea that Jesus brings justice?




4 | Activity

SUPPLIES

- Bibles
- Hand cutouts
- Heart cutouts
- Feet cutouts
- Writing/drawing supplies
- · Large craft sticks
- Yarn
- Stapler
- Tape

INSTRUCTIONS

- a. Discuss:
 - Have you ever seen someone treated unfairly?
 What happened?
 - Did you do anything to stop it? If so, what did you do? If not, what are some ways you could help stop something similar in the future?
 - How would you explain justice to a friend?
 - How did we see Jesus bring justice in today's story?
 - What are some ways we can bring justice to the people around us?
- b. Show the kids how to find Micah 6:8 in the Bible.
- c. Read the verse out loud.
- d. Chat about what this verse means.
- e. Emphasize that Jesus helps us see what it looks like to act justly, love mercy, and walk humbly.
- f. Give cutouts of a hand, a heart, and a foot to each person.
- g. Place the writing/drawing supplies where they can be shared.
- h. Guide the kids to write "Act justly" on the hands, "Love mercy" on the hearts, and "Walk humbly" on the feet. They could also draw pictures.
- i. Give each person three lengths of yarn and a craft stick.
- Help the kids staple one piece of yarn to each of their cutouts.
- k. Guide them to tape the yarn to their craft sticks.
- I. Encourage the kids to display their crafts!



5 | Key Verse & Pray

INSTRUCTIONS

- b. Read the Key Verse out loud together.
- c. Discuss: People tend not to think about love and justice at the same time. How does this verse show that they're connected?
- d. Explain that Jesus brings justice by helping others. He sacrificed his life for us in the ultimate act of help! We can give our lives for others and show them love by helping them.
- e. Direct everyone to think of a friend or a family member for whom they want to pray.
- f. Invite the kids to speak their individual prayers softly together. Encourage them to pray:
 - for any specific needs this person may have;
 - that this person would be open to God and become a follower of Jesus if not already;
 - and that God would use the kids to reach their friends and family members!
