On the 20th of March a total of 85 people are coming from three churches, from three different states, to build seven houses. They are all coming with different projects in mind, many details, many desires, many opportunities to bless and to make a difference. I have been working on the logistics for this

large group - it sometimes feels like a military operation. Next week Suzanne and I will be going to Mexico on a pastoral visit to spend time with and minister to the many people with whom I have developed a relationship. Please keep us in prayer:

- We want to see the young couple who nearly broke up because of his return to drugs ... they are reconciled and he has adjusted his ways.
- Pastor Bernardo has been distributing water to 17 families ... we need to explore the possibilities of expanding this distribution. He is also doing neighborhood school in the streets and doing a modified VBS for a number of children who are still not in school.
- Pastor Bernardo wants to take me around to visit several of the families in the church.
- Prayer and a focused time with my helper Zenaida who is always on hand when we take groups to her little village of San Francisco.
- There are still many needs in the immigration area. Many questions pop up and many approach me seeking advice or clarity.

We give thanks for the many opportunities that the Lord places in our path to speak of Him. Pray that we may be sensitive to His leading and that we be discerning of peoples needs.
