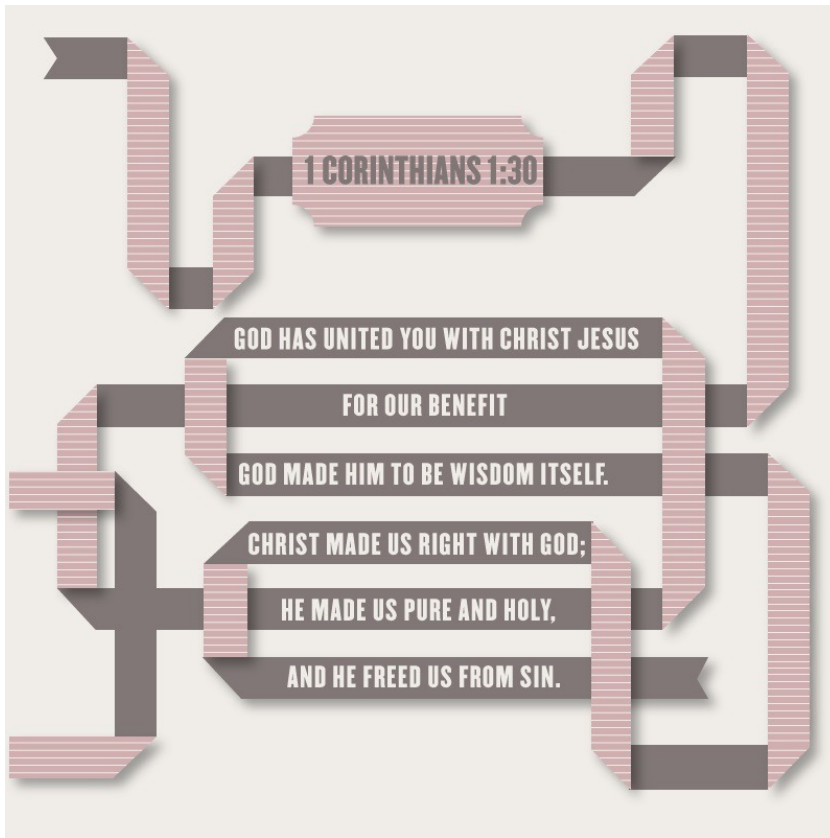

From Pastor Jared;

Chances are you want to become someone meaningful and do something meaningful in your life. Why? Because that is the nature of God, and you have been created to reflect Him. But do you ever wonder if you have what it takes? We have just spent an entire teaching series responding to this question and how we can see progress in our lives. So let us dive deeper into this subject. You could be at a crossroads right now where you have to make a decision regarding this desire. You could have a picture in your mind of who you want to become—a faithful follower of Jesus or someone who is a non-anxious presence to those around you. And, possibly, you even have an idea of what you want to do—start a business, raise a family, or live outrageously generously. What if I told you (or reminded you) that you have *everything* you need to reflect Jesus in these ways. Would you believe me?

As you may know, I love Legos. When I was a kid, I would cringe when I would see the unfortunate Lego sets of my friends combined together in one massive tub. How *dare* they do such a thing? My mind would race to the worst-case scenario, thinking, “What if they lose a piece they need?” Even worse than this though, was when I would get a brand new set, only to open it up and find one of the pieces was missing. How could I *possibly* move to the next step without that exact piece? My world would be wrecked for the day and possibly the week. *What was I going to do? Should I email them? Wait a second, I’m 10...I can’t email them.* Eventually I would have to cycle through the grieving process, accept the loss, and move on.

The truth is that Jesus is our source; we are His image, and we are called to reflect Him. Did you catch that? Jesus is your source for *everything* you need. Unlike those Lego sets, you have no missing pieces! 2 Peter 1:3 confirms it, “By His divine power, God has given us everything we need for living a godly life. We have come to know all of this by coming to know Him, the One Who called us to Himself.” In knowing Jesus, you have what it takes to reflect His image—the courage to take that risk, the peace to be content, or the power to walk in freedom from an addiction!

The problem is that we doubt this truth. Because we do not think that it really is possible to reflect Him, we reach for counterfeit pieces, settling for less-than. We trade a life of true fulfillment for comfort, reaching for things that we think will be our missing piece only to find them over-promising and under-delivering. Then, we find ourselves settling, whether that is for addictions instead of freedom or others’ affirmation rather than our Father’s confirmation. What is more, is that settling not only impacts us, but those around us. Read further along in 2 Peter and he warns about the danger of false teachers. Why? I think he wanted to point-out what is possible when people do not realize they have everything they need in Jesus and live with missing pieces. They are a disaster waiting to happen.

You are an image-bearer of God and nothing will ever change that. Because of Jesus, you have everything you need for living a godly life—for reflecting Him! There are no missing pieces! You have what it takes to be a faithful follower of Jesus and to do what He’s called you to do! How can you realize this for yourself? Take some time and reflect for a second on any negative emotions you may have been feeling recently. It could be fear, criticism, inferiority, anger, or emptiness. This would be your missing piece. Now take it a step further and ask God what characteristic(s) of His fills the void caused by that missing piece. His faithfulness could replace your fear, or His calming presence could soothe that anger. Since Jesus is your source and you are His image, go and reflect His image by living-out a life with no missing pieces. Jesus calling you to live this way is never a demand for “more,” but an invitation to go deeper. Deeper into who He has created you to become and into what He has called you to do.

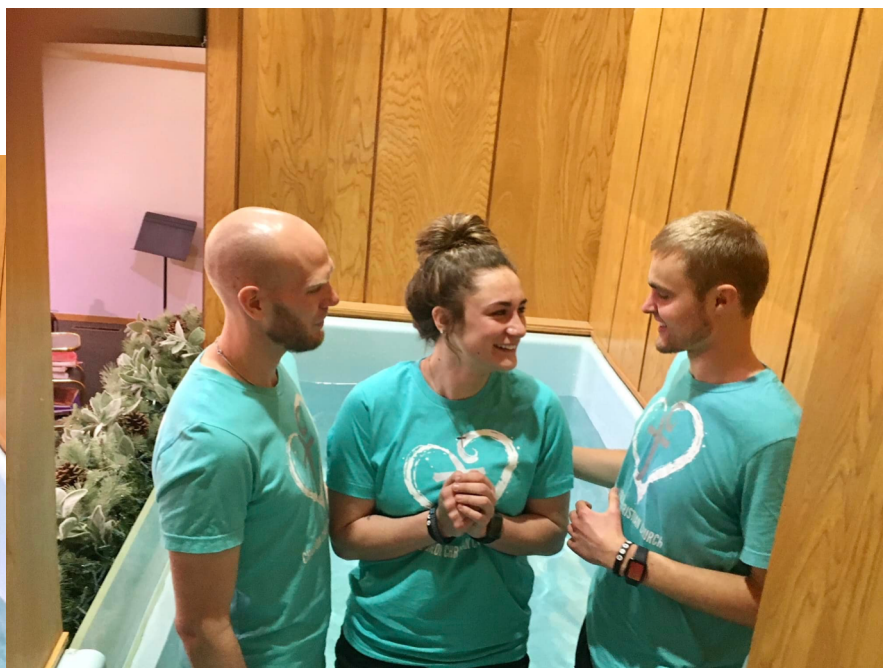
