They did this every day and it was as if the city stood still, such was the power of prayer. The result was

so overwhelming that the bombings were stopped after a short time!

Now we are organizing again, a group of people of different nationalities, to spend a minute praying for the peace, well-being and security of our countries, for an end to the problems that oppress, and for Spirit-guided decisions of leaders around the world.
