#### 2. Death and Punishment

<u>I believe</u> God expects perfection from us. But none of us even come close to that.

Worse yet, God tells us there is a punishment in store for those who sin.

"For the wages of sin is death."

Romans 6:23a

That's not only physical death, it's eternal, spiritual death. It's punishment in hell.



### 1. Creation and Sin

<u>I believe</u> in a God who is perfect. That's how He created our world—everything was good!

But sadly, the human beings that God created sinned against Him. That sin spread to everyone—no exceptions.

"All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." Romans 3:23



### 3. Salvation

I believe God loves us and provided a way out of that punishment. God sent His Son, Jesus, to us—who is both God and human. Jesus lived a perfect life for us. Then He died on the cross and rose from the dead to save us.

"God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." Romans 5:8



### 4. Eternal Life

we can have our sins
forgiven by God
and also live forever.

"The gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." Romans 6:23b



## 6. Holy Spirit Lives in Me

<u>I believe</u> God's Holy Spirit lives in me, filling me with God's love and helping me live God's way.

"God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us... The Spirit helps us in our weakness... Those who are led by the Spirit of God are the children of God."
