"The Marriage Baseline - Trust!"

Proverbs 3:5-6; I Samuel 1:1-19 Lead Pastor | Bobby Alger March 06, 2022

- 1. Establishing a four-way trust in marriage.
 - Hannah's husband was trustworthy to take her to worship. (1 Samuel 1:3-5)
 - Hannah knew who to take her problems to. (1 Samuel 1:10)
 - She trusted only God's ability on her behalf. (1 Samuel 1:11)
 - She trusted the priest without offense. (1 Samuel 1:12-17)
 - She left her burden with God, trusting he would act. (1 Samuel 1:18)
 - She followed through to be trustworthy to God. (1 Samuel 1:24-28)
- **2.** How to identify the <u>absence</u> of trust. But for all this, you did not trust the Lord your God (Deuteronomy 1:32).
 - No <u>open</u> discussion because of <u>fear</u>.
 - No <u>vulnerability</u> allowed.
 - Constant questioning of <u>motives</u>.
- **3.** <u>Building</u> back the baseline of <u>trust</u> in your marriage. Trust in the LORD with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take (Proverbs 3:5-6). NLT
 - Ask for forgiveness. It brings accountability in. (Matthew 6:14-15; John 20:23)
 - Make your <u>actions</u> match your <u>words</u>. (James 2:20-22)
 - Ask how you can restore trust with them. (John 14:1)
 - Tell them why you love them. It shows value. (Luke 15:31-32)
 - Make eye contact/offer meaningful touch. (Mark 10:21)
