Sermon Study Questions

1. The Westminster Shorter Catechism defines repentance in the following way -  
“Repentance unto life is a saving grace whereby a sinner, out of a true sense of his sin, and apprehension of the mercy of God in Christ, doth, with grief and hatred of his sin, turn from it unto God, with full purpose of, and endeavour after, new obedience.”
2. By this definition, what are the main elements of repentance? Do you agree with this definition of repentance?
3. The repentant person does not appeal to God for justice. To what does he appeal according to Psalm 51:1-2?
4. According to Psalm 51:7 who removes the stain of sin from us? Can we do it ourselves?
5. According to Eph.2:8-9 do good works shown to others contribute to our salvation in any way? If not, what does lead to our salvation?
6. Is there such a thing as false guilt? If you do believe there is, give examples.
7. Read 2 Cor.7:10. What is the difference between godly sorrow and worldly sorrow?
8. Read Isaiah 55:7. What is the challenge for us contained in this verse? What is the promise?
9. From Acts11:18, where is the source of a repentant heart?
