Sermon Study Questions

1. Read 1 Cor.12:12. What was the Apostle Paul seeking to teach the Corinthian Christians by his using the illustration of the human body?
2. State two important truths coming from 1 Cor.12:7?
3. Read 1 Cor.12:11. Who is the One who decides which Christian receives which gift?
4. In 1 Cor.4:7 the Apostle Paul warns his readers not to boast about their gifts. Why would it make no sense to boast about the gift you have been given? Do you think it is tempting for some to do this? Why/why not?
5. Read 1 Cor.4:7-11. In this passage the gift of faith is mentioned. This does not refer to the gift of salvation. What do you think the gift of faith refers to here?
6. In 2 Tim.1:6 the Apostle Paul tells Timothy to “fan his gift into flame.” What do you think Paul meant by this? Is there a sense in which we also are required to fan our gift into flame? Why/why not?
7. Are natural gifts the same as spiritual gifts?
8. Which types of service bring you joy?
9. Where have you seen Kingdom fruit coming from your service to others?
10. Do you know areas where the Holy Spirit has gifted you?
11. If we are uncertain where our gifts lie, many would advise us simply to become involved where opportunities of service already exist. Why would this be a good idea?
12. John Maxwell has written, “When you find your spiritual gift, God will give you an opportunity to use it.” Do you think this is true? Why/why not?
