Sermon Study Questions

1. If someone was to ask you, "why do you think there is so much suffering in the world," what would you say?
2. Read Isaiah 2:4. Do you think this will ever come about? Why/why not? If you believe it will, how do you think it will happen?
3. What would some of the more common reasons be for rejecting Christ today? From Ps.2:1-2, are the anti-God positions of many in our world today deliberate or accidental? If you believe the position is deliberately taken, where do you think the verses show this?
4. What do you think is making God laugh in Ps.2:4?
5. We are told in Ps.2:5 that God becomes angry. Why?
6. Does Heb.10:31 surprise you? Does it make you uncomfortable? Why might some become uncomfortable with this verse and not wish to believe it?
7. Psalm 2 is known as a Messianic Psalm. What do you think this term means?
8. Read John 3:17-19. From these verses, why do you think so much of the world has rejected Christ?
9. What does Eph.6:12 tell us about the reality of spiritual evil? How does it usually present itself?
10. From Rom.3:23, who needs to receive forgiveness from God?
11. Read Rev.6:15-17. When Christ comes again not everyone will be pleased. Who will seek to hide from His presence?
