## 2021 PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

### Refugee Resettlement

In December, LSI began welcoming individuals and families who were evacuated from Afghanistan. LSI will resettle up to 450 Afghans throughout Iowa, including in the Siouxland area, during 2021 and 2022, connecting them with housing, employment, language classes, and other services to help them thrive in their new home state.

### Kinship Navigator Program

LSI's Foster Care and Adoption Team is working with the Iowa Department of Human Services to help children in foster care stay connected with their families. The Kinship model offers support to relatives who temporarily care for a child while the child's parents work toward family reunification.
