Relay for Life Follow Up: Thank you everyone for your generosity in giving toward Relay for Life functions whether it be through simple donations, luminary bags, or the spaghetti meal. Our team reached their highest level ever, the silver level, with \$4,207 and the most luminaria bags purchased for display. THANK YOU!! Overall the Relay for Life community fundraiser exceeded their goal of \$75,000 by \$12,000 and they are still collecting till August of this year. There were 262 spaghetti meals purchased and 258 luminary bags displayed. There were 26 teams raising money and many participants at the event. There were also 45 survivors walking at the event representing 675 years since their cancer diagnosis. That is awesome!
